



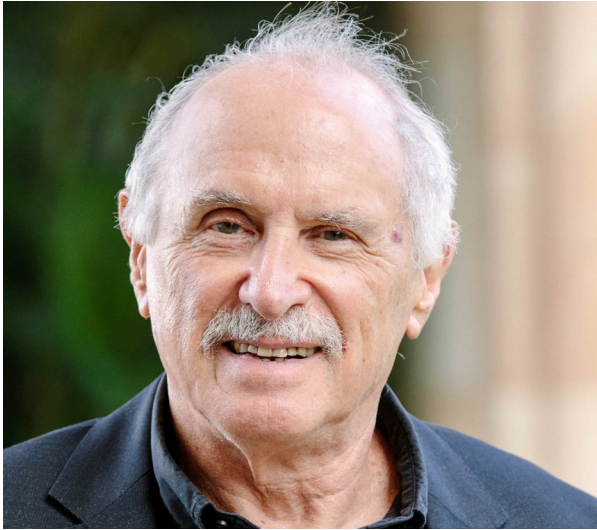

The Rechnitz Fund

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander scholars and knowledge and understanding of Indigenous society, languages and cultures

Australia-France Indo-Pacific Studies Program

Grants, visiting Fellowships and strategic dialogues to reinforce social science collaboration between Australia and France.

Purpose

Eligibility



- Social science, encourage multidisciplinary
- At least one Academy Fellow

- Participants include at least two EMCRs
- Hosted in Australia
- Requested funding does not exceed AUD\$9,000 (excl. GST)
- At least one convenor employed by an organisation with capacity to manage, acquit and report on grant expenditure.

Selection criteria



Need and relevance

Advances contemporary research and policy agendas on nationally important issues

Program design

Activities, themes, sessions and speakers are an effective vehicle to achieve objectives

Participants

Number of attendees conducive to deep dialogue.
Diverse. Relevant expertise.
Significant portion has confirmed attendance

Outcomes and impact

Well-considered plan to disseminate / amplify outputs.
Clear understanding of desired impacts on research, policy or practice

Budget

Allocations clearly outlined and align with objectives.
Efforts to leverage co-investment or in-kind support, to amplify impact.
