

### Purpose

### Eligibility



- Social science, encourage multidisciplinarity
- At least one Academy Fellow https://socialsciences.org.au/fellows-directory/
- Participants include at least two EMCRs
- Hosted in Australia
- Requested funding does not exceed AUD\$9,000 (excl. GST)
- At least one convenor employed by an organisation with capacity to manage, acquit and report on grant expenditure.

### **Selection criteria**



#### Need and relevance

Advances contemporary research and policy agendas on nationally important issues

#### Program design

Activities, themes, sessions and speakers are an effective vehicle to achieve objectives

#### **Participants**

Number of attendees conducive to deep dialogue.

Diverse. Relevant expertise.

Significant portion has confirmed attendance

### Outcomes and impact

Well-considered plan to disseminate / amplify outputs.

Clear understanding of desired impacts on research, policy or practice

### Budget

Allocations clearly outlined and align with objectives.

Efforts to leverage coinvestment or in-kind support, to amplify impact.
