

GOVERNMENT FINANCE

AUSTRALIAN GOVERNMENTS provide a variety of services to the community, the range of which has widened considerably since 1850. They maintain law and order and public safety, including defence against invasion. They provide health and education services and pay pensions to persons in disadvantaged circumstances. Governments supply transport and communication services (including roads, harbours and airports), water and sewerage services, banking and insurance services and gas and electrical energy. They also support some industries with bounties, subsidies and assistance such as research. Finally, governments undertake a wide range of activities designed to regulate the economy, protect the environment, and ensure safe products and working conditions. To pay for these services they raise taxes, sell some of their services, such as rail transport, make charges for others, such as the issue of birth certificates, sell assets, such as land, and borrow.

The tables in this chapter are designed to show, in a simplified form, the money-raising and spending activities of Australian colonial, state, commonwealth and local governments, from 1850 to 1982. Some striking changes emerge from the record of those 132 years.

The pre-eminent function of colonial governments after 1856 was the development of the country's resources through building and operating railway, postal and telegraph systems. These businesses dominated total government expenditure and revenue until the end of the 1920s. On average, more than one-half of the annual spending in these fields between 1856 and 1892 was carried out with borrowed money, somewhat less than one-third in the 1920s and about one-third since World War II. Consequently, debt charges—interest payments and repayments from revenue—became a heavy burden. This did not matter as long as a substantial proportion was covered by the operating surpluses of government businesses. From the 1920s, however, this became less common; indeed operating losses were sometimes incurred, especially in the 1950s.

From the 1920s and 1930s, but most dramatically from the 1950s, social expenditure—on health, education and social security—became the major source of increased total government spending. In addition, especially since the 1950s, the costs of general administration, covering an extended range of government functions, have risen very significantly.

Until the late 1880s, governments were able to increase their total expenditure without increasing the tax burden (the ratio of taxes to gross domestic product). This is because they

borrowed heavily, because selling and leasing crown land produced substantial revenue, particularly during the 1870s, and because business operating expenses were covered by business revenue. From the end of the 1920s borrowing was much less important (except during World War II) and from 1890 land revenue progressively became less important and, finally, almost insignificant as a source of funds.

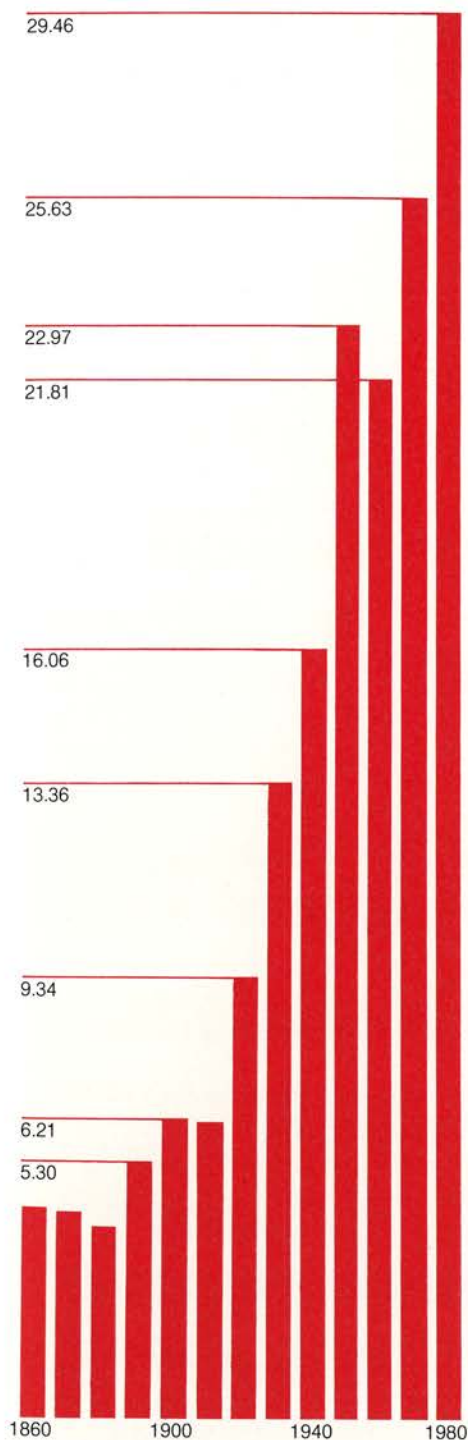
The other major source of government revenue is taxation. Until the late 1880s it consisted overwhelmingly of customs and excise duties, with taxes on some business activities providing a minor supplement. Many new taxes were subsequently introduced when other revenue sources failed to keep pace with rising expenditure. The most important was income tax, first raised in Tasmania in 1880 and becoming widespread in the 1890s: from World War II, it provided at least one-half of annual taxation revenue.

The cost of government—the tax burden—increased very considerably between 1911 and 1933 and again during World War II. Commonwealth spending on war, repatriation, veterans' pensions and war-related charges was very large. It was essentially the activities of states, however, that were responsible for raising the tax burden above its war-time level in the 1920s and, despite new commonwealth taxes, for lifting it further early in the 1930s. After World War II, when taxation had reached very high levels, the tax burden was reduced, and it remained constant until about the mid-1960s, though at a level very much higher than before the war. More recently, there has been a gradual rise caused by increasing expenditure on education, health and social security as well as on more extensive government regulation.

In this overall picture, the relative importance of different tiers of government has changed. Local government was always a minor element. It was small and to a large extent its expenditure was financed by colonial or state government grants. When the colonies federated in 1901 they surrendered some limited financial powers and responsibilities to the new commonwealth government. Subsequently the central government became more important. By 1942 its expenditure and revenue exceeded that of all states combined. This was due to war-time demands and to the fact that the levying of income tax became a commonwealth monopoly in that year, as had customs duties in 1901. Since then, revenue raised by the states themselves has rarely exceeded one-third of that raised by the commonwealth, and the states have been dependent on commonwealth grants to meet much of their expenditure.

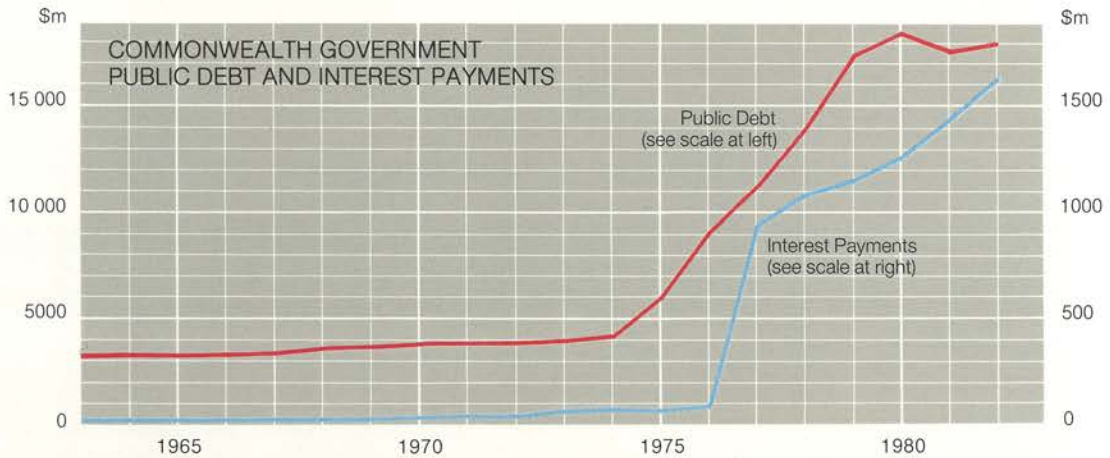

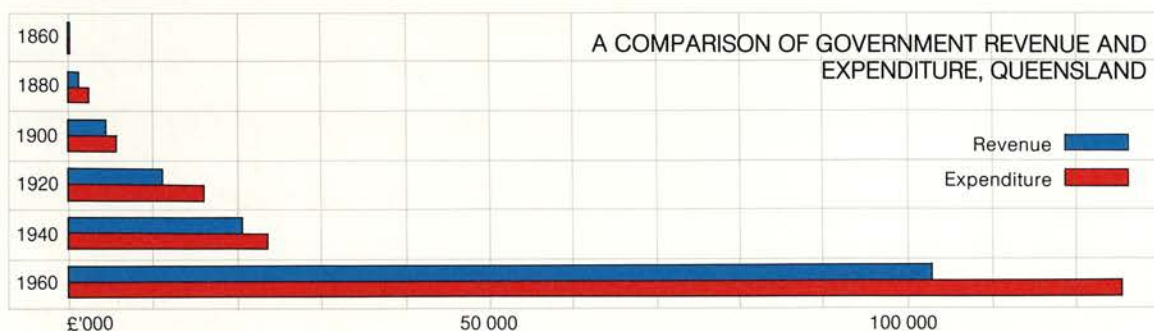

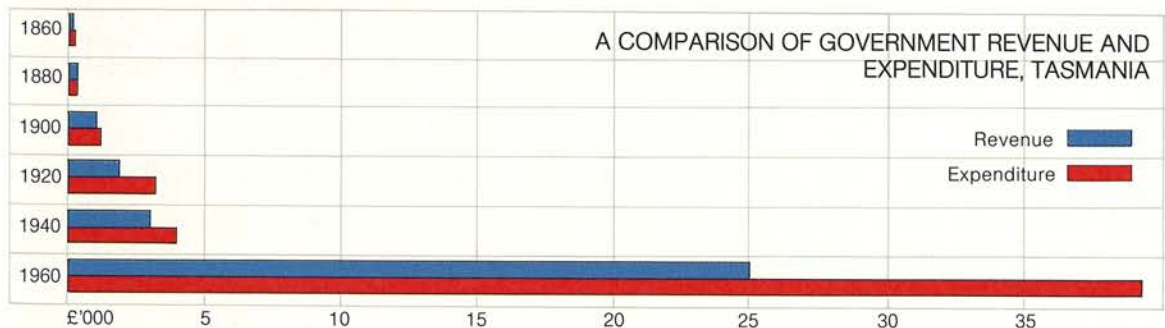

GF 121-135 WESTERN AUSTRALIA, PUBLIC DEBT, REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE 1851-1968

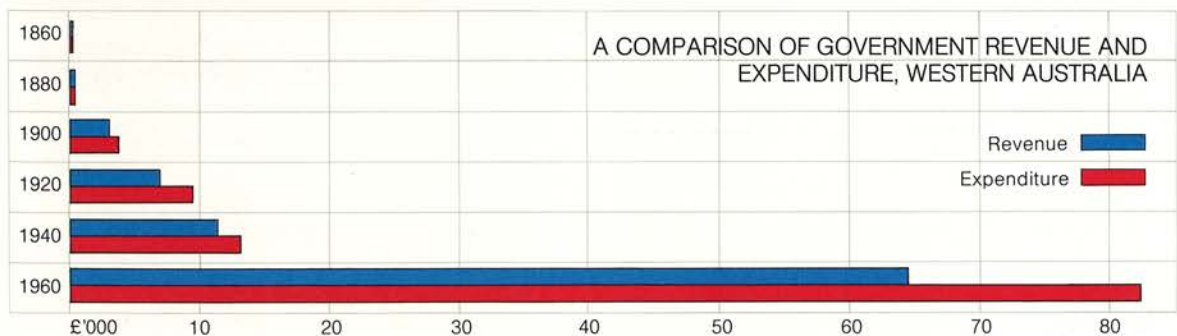

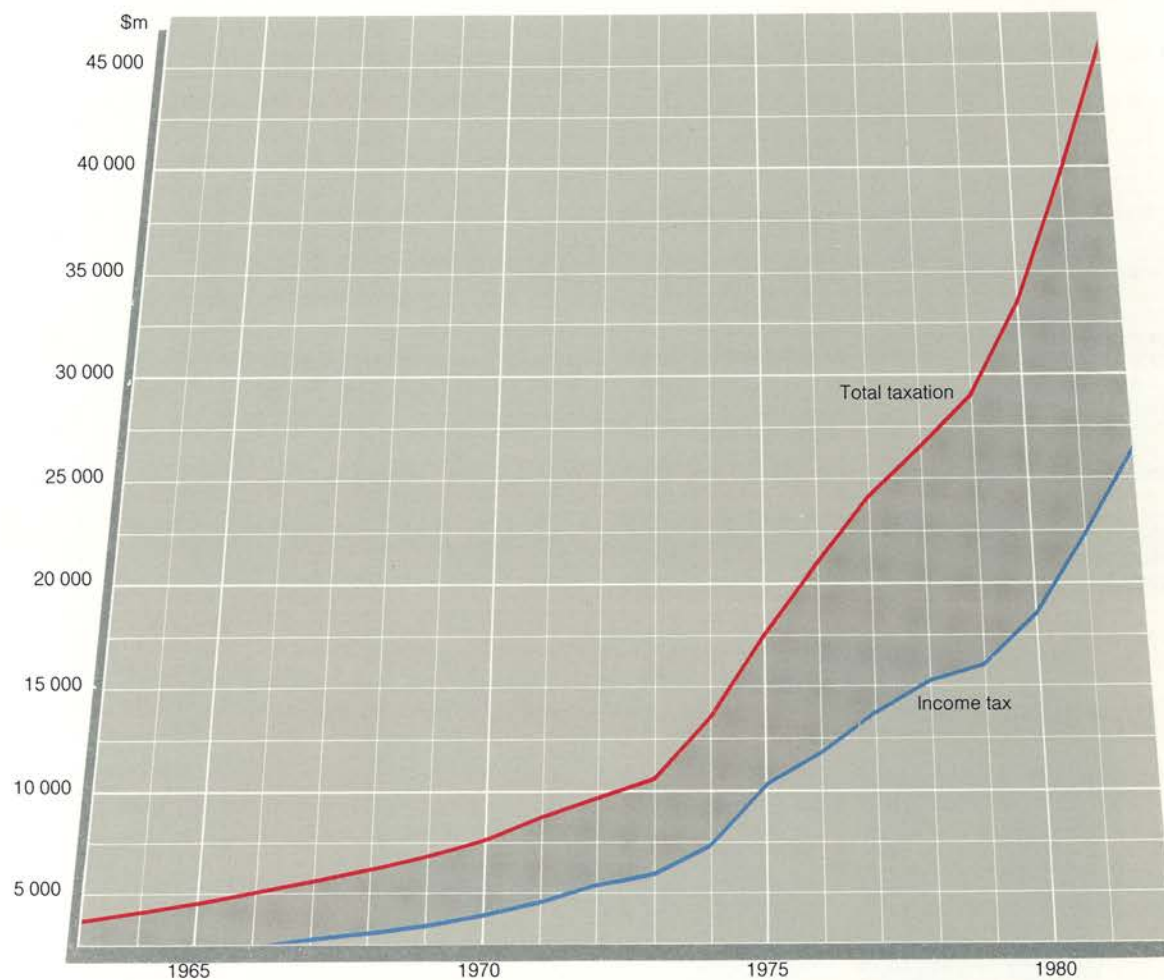
